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

- W3150 rear replacement bumper
- W3150-HW fastener kit
- 4 Stud Plates
- Instruction Manual

Tools Required

- Socket Wrench with Extension (Ratcheting wrenches may also be convenient)
- 15mm, 18mm, & 22mm Sockets and Box End Wrenches
- Hex Bit Socket for #8-32 Button Head
- Flat and Phillips Head Screw Drivers
- Floor Jack and wood block.
- II. Removal of Stock Bumper
 - A. Remove license plate, and OEM license plate lights. Disconnect trailer receptacle. If equipped, unplug back-up sensor harness.
 - B. Remove the two fasteners connecting the hitch to the stock bumper located on either side of the receiver with an 18mm socket. Using a 22mm socket disconnect the fasteners connecting the hitch receiver to the frame. Save hardware for reuse.





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C. Remove the fasteners connecting the bumper mounts to the frame. This requires removing one bolt from the bottom of the frame (#22 socket/wrench) and three bolts from the side of the frame (#22 and #15 socket/wrench). Save hardware for reuse.

- D. Remove OEM bumper by pulling it rearward away from the truck.
- E. Remove OEM Spare Tire Access Cover and Trailer Plug from the OEM bumper. Set aside for reinstallation.
- F. Re-install Hitch Receiver



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
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


III. Rear Bumper Installation

NOTE: The Following Installation steps apply to the installation of the Rear Bumper. PLEASE READ THE ENTIRE MANUAL BEFORE ATEMPTING INSTALLATION! Ignoring these steps will increase your probability of scratching the vehicle during product Installation!

- A. Remove the Bumper from the shipping carton. Lay all items out on a blanket to prevent damage to the powder coating.
- B. Install license plate nylon nut inserts in 4 provided locations.





C. Remove the factory harness from the center section of the OEM bumper.

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D. Install the light covers into the bumper by first positioning them properly in the brackets and then screw them in at bottom of bracket.



E. Install factory harness on Fab Fours bumper and insert light attached to harness into light cover and secure. Use zip-ties to secure excess wiring. Holes for securing zip-ties are located at (Ref. Figure 11)



F. Install trailer plug and Tag light in indicated sockets.




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
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- G. Reconnect tag light and trailer plug. Use zip-ties to secure excess wiring.
- H. Install supplied intermediate mounting brackets to the hitch frame plate using ½" socket and wrench for three bracket bolts. Two bolts are located on the side and one underneath of the hitch frame plate. Refer to the Figure 10 and Figure 11, Figure 10 indicating bolts in green circles. Reuse screw and c-clip from OEM bumper. Complete on both driver and passenger sides of vehicle. <u>Do Not Fully Tighten, Finger Tighten Only!</u>






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- I. With the help of others and possibly a floor jack to support the center of the bumper, lift the Fab Fours bumper into place.
- J. Insert the set of stud plates, facing away from bumper, into the slots on the internal mounting tower. Complete on both driver and passenger sides of vehicle. Refer to the Figure 10 and Figure 11, Figure 10 indicates the plates in red blocks.
- K. Align the bumper side to side and top to bottom to ensure a perfect fit to the truck. Allow at least 0.250" of clearance to all painted surfaces if possible. This is to allow for frame flex!
- L. Check that the tailgate does not interfere with the bumper by opening it very carefully and lowering it into place. If tailgate is to close to the bumper, adjust bumper lower.
- M. Fully tighten all fasteners between bumper and brackets as well as brackets and frame. (Ref. Figure11a-b)



N. Insert M10 blot and fasten down with provided hex head nut. (Ref. 11c)

- O. Install supplied license plate plastic nut inserts and license plate.
- P. Enjoy your New Rear Replacement Bumper from Fab Fours!



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
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Maintenance/Care
