




1. Remove contents from box, verify if all parts listed are present and free from damage. Carefully read and understand all instructions before attempting installation.




2. Proceed to the passenger side rocker panel and locate the black rubber plugs and remove them see **Figure 1**. For bracket C (Item 3) mount location, install M8 nut clip (Item 8) as shown in **Figure 2**. Proceed to install the remaining M8 nut clips as shown in **Figure 3**.













3. Take the mounting brackets and install the bracket and associated hardware loosely to it's corresponding positions see **Figures 4**, **5**, **and 6**. Do not fully tighten hardware at this time. **Note:** On 1500 crew cab models, front positions will have a welded nut on pinch weld and must refer to **Figure 4** for bracket installation.







- 4. See Step Bar Instructions (Step Bars sold separately) for information on attaching the bars to the brackets.
- 5. Make sure the mounting brackets and step bar are aligned then proceed to fully tighten all hardware. Recommended torque values are 15-18 ft-lbs for M8 hex head bolts and 5-7 ft-lbs for M6 fasteners.


For 2015-2016 Diesel equipped models: The DEF tank must be removed prior to installing the brackets on the passenger side. For DEF tank removal instructions please refer to **page 7**.

For 2017-2019 Diesel equipped models: *DEF tank removal is not necessary for 2017-2019 diesel equipped models*. Only need to remove DEF tank plastic cover in order to install mount brackets. Refer to **Step 3**.

- 3. Using a 10MM wrench, remove the four bolts that hold the DEF tank plastic cover to the vehicle. See **Figure 4.**
- 4. Take the mounting brackets and install the bracket and associated hardware loosely to it's corresponding positions see **Figures 5, 6, and 7**. Brackets used for the passenger side are (1) bracket C (Item 3), (1) bracket D (Item 4) and (2) bracket B (Item 2). The driver side will use the remaining (2) bracket B and (2) bracket A (Item 1). Do not fully tighten hardware at this time. **Note:** Bracket location is critical.



DEF TANK REMOVAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR 2015-2016 (NOT REQUIRED FOR 2017-2019)







Step 4. Using a ratchet with a long extension and a 13mm socket loosen and remove the bolts of the tank support straps. (depending on model, bolts may be 13mm head socket or Torx T-40 bit.)




Step 6. Carefully bring the tank down trying not to tilt or twist the tank to avoid damage to connectors.

Note: Trimming might be required on the plastic cover, at the bracket location.




- 5. For 2017 Diesel equipped models: Proceed to reinstall DEF tank plastic cover.
- 6. **For 2015-2016 Diesel equipped models:** Proceed to reinstall the DEF tank.
- 7. See Step Bar Instructions (Step Bars sold separately) for information on attaching the bars to the brackets.
- 8. Make sure the mounting brackets and step bar are aligned then proceed to fully tighten all hardware. Recommended torque values are 15-18 ft-lbs for M8 hex head bolts.
