
PROCEDURE

- 1. Remove contents from box, verify if all parts listed are present and free from damage. Carefully read and understand all instructions before attempting installation.
 - Failure to identify damage before installation could lead to a rejection of any claim.
- 2. Beginning on the driver side of the vehicle, remove (2) M10 OEM bolts from each mounting location on the rocker panel. See **Figure 1**.





3. Loosely secure (1) Front Mount Bracket (item 1) to the rocker panel using the supplied M10 hardware (items 4-6). See **Figures 1 & 2**.





4. Loosely secure (1) Center Mount Bracket (item 2) and (1) Rear Mount Bracket (item 3) to the rocker panel using the supplied M10 hardware (items 4-6). See **Figures 3 & 4**.






- 5. Move to the passenger side of the vehicle and repeat **Steps 2-4**.
- $6. \quad \text{Fasten running boards respectively to either side using the 5/16" hardware provided with the step bars (items 7-9)} \ .$


- Note 1: Running boards sold separately.
- *Note 2:* For Grate Steps Running Boards, refer to the installation instructions included with the running boards.
- 7. Align and adjust the running boards and brackets as needed and fully tighten all hardware. Torque all 5/16" fasteners to 15-18 ft-lbs, and all M10 fasteners to 30-35 ft-lbs.


